### **Praise and Thanksgiving and Recent Events**

- CLRC hosted a weekend retreat by the RCCC NCSU Student Fellowship from 1/21-22, 2012 with speaker Pastor Tran.
- The annual Board of Directors meeting was held on December 30, 2011. The agenda included a review of current status, board business, future plans, needs and prayer requests. Much discussion and many good suggestions were made regarding CLRC's ministry.
